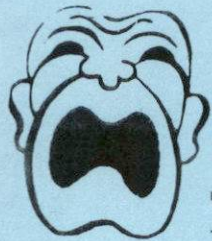

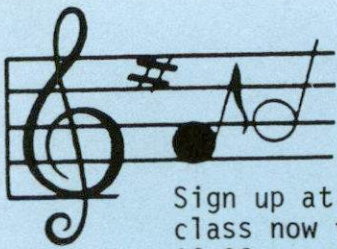
SPECIAL ELECTION UPDATE Campaign Week!

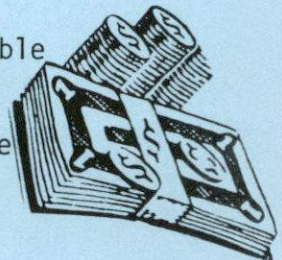
OHIO UNIVERSITY PREREGISTRATION
