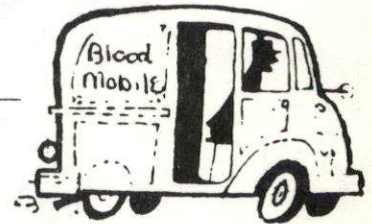


GRADUATE PICTURES

OHIO UNIVERSITY PRE-REGISTRATION

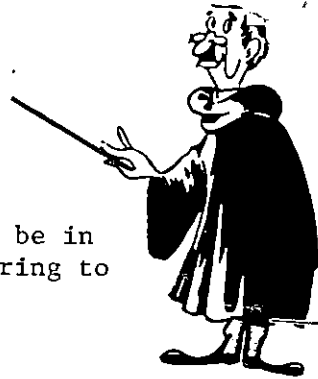
