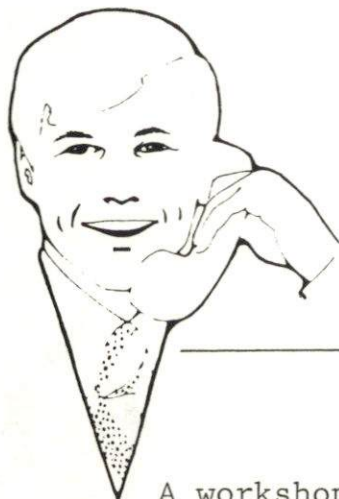

Help is needed in organizing game booths. Please contact a Student Senate member if you can help.

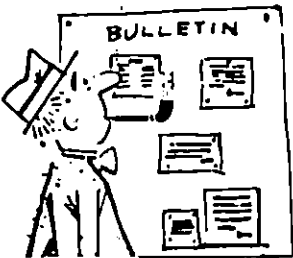
