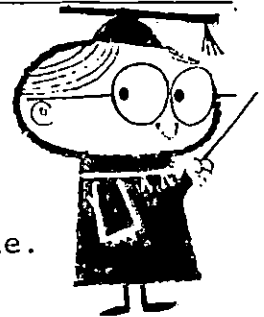
### SUMMER REGISTRATION

### GRADUATION

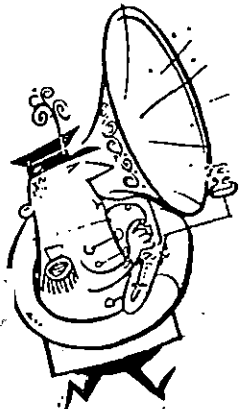
