New business comes from the EPCC. EPCC is recommending a proposal from Engineering Technology for a new Associate Degree Program in Computer Aided Design (CAD). Engineering Technology currently offers a 1-year certificate in CAD. There is also a policy being presented for granting university credit for non-university-classroom experiences. The policy helps clarify the number of credits by arrangement, credits by examination including CLEP, and credits for experimental and/or military training that the university will accept.

The policy on "Review and Approval of Existing Academic Programs" is unfinished business.
