"MIDNIGHT CRUISE"

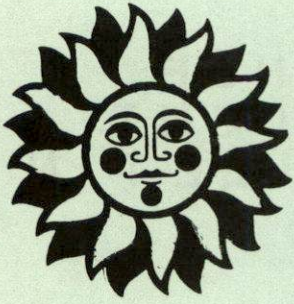
The Student Senate will be sponsoring a semi-formal dance on the Gateway Clipper boat on June 8, 1979, from 9 p.m. till 1 a.m.
