He is a professor of English at Jefferson Community College, Louisville, Kentucky. He has written eleven books and four plays. The schedule for the day is as follows:

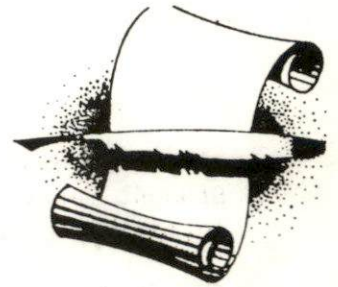
