Mr. Taylor reported on the status of the funding for the building program. An agreement has been reached with Mercy Hospital to provide housing for 25 female students next year. The possibility of obtaining some housing facilities for male students is also being investigated.

The progress on the road construction is moving very slowly. Present indications are that construction may begin in mid-August 1975.
