## APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Morgan moved and Mr. Hyland seconded the motion to approve the minutes of the September 17, 1979 Board of Trustees meeting.

Mr. Strafford introduced Mr. Taylor to speak about the Capital Improvements Bill that is now in the Ohio Legislature.

Shawnee State is earmarked to receive \$5 million if the bill is approved by the Legislature. The money is to be used for four line items:

Renovation of Massie Hall \$ 432,000

Nursing Addition and Parking

Lots 864,000

Land Acquisition and Preparation 970,000 Natatorium and Student Center 2,734,000

The Board of Regents has indicated that plans should be completed for the Nursing Addition. The Architecture work has already been completed for this phase of the project. Parking is also a problem and this phase of the project should be designated for completion as soon as possible. There will be an additional parking space for 650 cars when this part of the project is complete. The Capital Improvements Bill has passed the House of Representatives and been sent to the Senate. The Governor is encouraging a quick passage of this bill in order to give employment to people in Ohio.

Mr. Hyland moved that the Nursing Addition and Parking Lot projects be approved for completion as soon as the money is available from this Capital Improvements Bill. Mr. Morgan seconded the motion.

The other phases of the building program will have to be referred to committee. Plans will have to be made, architects chosen, etc. after the money has finally been approved.
